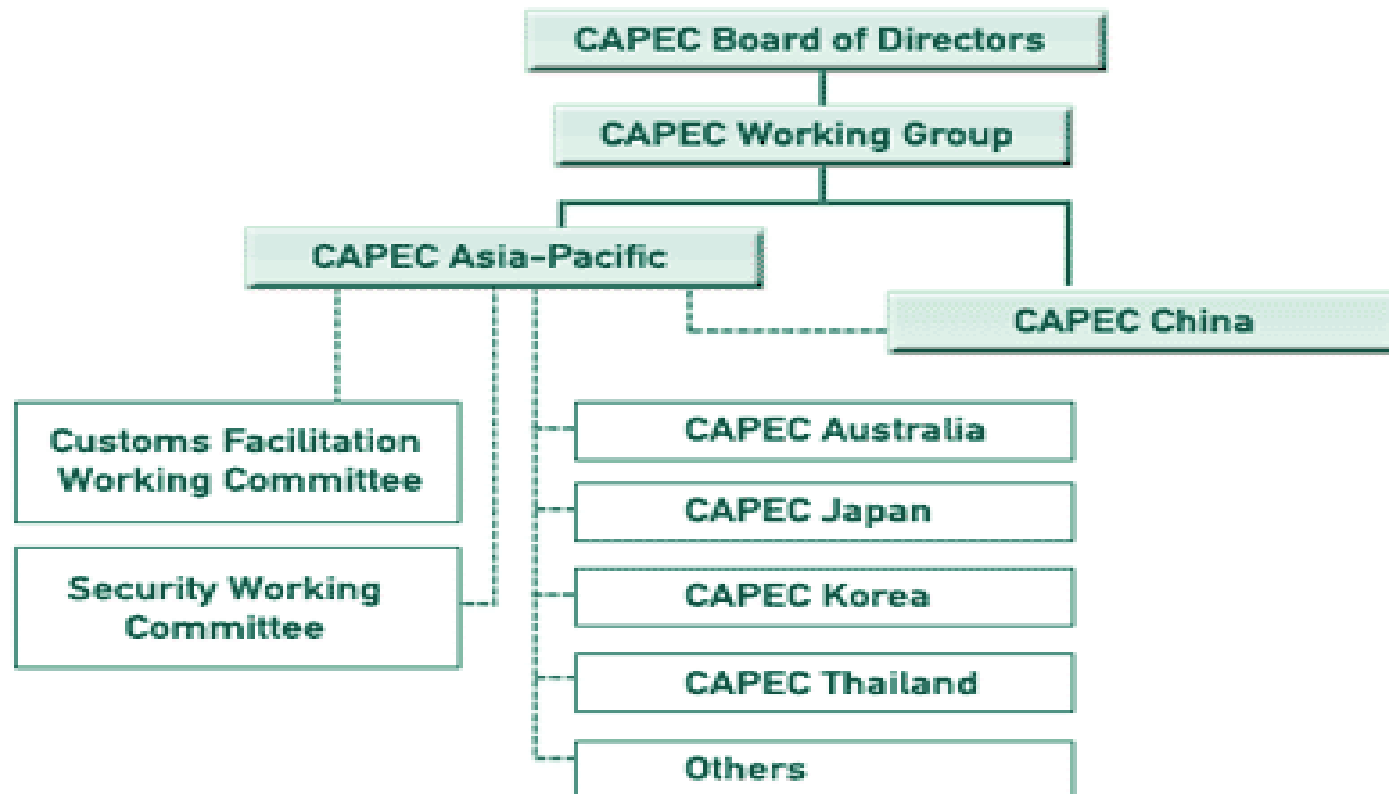

- Continuous 20% annual growth between 1996 and 2006
- By 2017, Air Express industry is expected to represent almost 36% of global air cargo
